

IMPROVING WEDDING VENUE ACOUSTICS

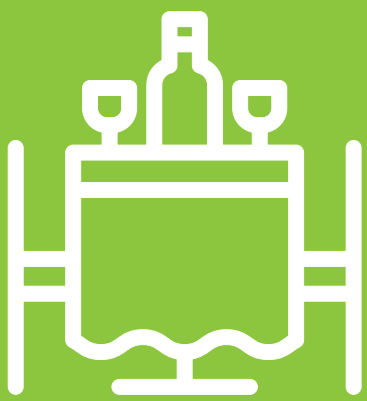


COMFORTABLE CELEBRATION

If your wedding venue is in the middle of nowhere, noise compliance is not necessarily a key component; however, if your wedding venue is near residences, noise compliance is crucial

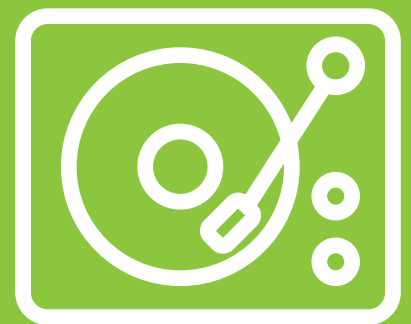


ROOM LAYOUT
